Clinical Supervision- 3 day training Wednesday-Friday, May 19-21, 2010 at Hanley Main Campus (9:00am-4:00pm)

Instructor: Jim Knorp **Goal:** Participants will learn to understand the tasks and functions of the clinical supervisor and improve their personal ability to give effective job performance feedback. They will also learn how to construct a supervisory interview to achieve specific goals. They will design a learning plan to improve counselor performance, demonstrate familiarity with the Addiction Counseling Competencies: Knowledge, Skills and Attitudes of Professional practice and assess counselor proficiency in the Competencies.

****CAP Prep- 2 day training Thursday-Friday, May 20-21, 2010 at Hanley Resource Center (9:00am-4:00pm)**

Instructor: Dave Ornoski **Goal:** The Addiction Certifications Exam Review course teaches participants the FCB's role in credentialing addiction professionals, explains the relationship between the Addiction Professional Role Delineation Study and the Written Exam, and provides a thorough review of the core knowledge, skills, and abilities expected of Addiction Professionals.

Bob's Boxes- 1 day training Thursday, May 20, 2010 at Hanley Resource Center (9:00am-4:00pm)

Instructor: Robert Piper **Goal:** To understand the disease concept of addiction disorders and clarifying the types of "usage" other than disease progression. Participants will also understand the co-occurring possibilities of mental illness and "keys" to recovery explored.

Addictive Brain- 1 day training Thursday, May 20, 2010 at Hanley Resource Center (9:00am-4:00pm)

Instructor: Dr. Barbara Krantz **Goal:** Learner will understand the definition of the disease of addiction; the biochemical genetic defect related to the disease that chemical dependency is a brain disease; the activation of the reward pathway by addictive drugs; why imaging of the brain is critical for the diagnosis and treatment; the use of SPECT scans and the related studies regarding the treatment, progress and the research currently being conducted related to the brain disease concept.

Aging and Addiction- 1 day training Friday, May 21, 2010 at Hanley Resource Center (9:00am-4:00pm)

Instructor: Juan Harris **Goal:** Participants will learn the complexity of diagnosis and treatment of substance abuse in older adults. They will be able to differentiate substance abuse between the older adults and younger adult populations, including barriers to treatment, identifying signs and symptoms, and modalities of treatment between age groups.
